

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for

(System Name) Well on Wheels Inc.

Our water system recently violated a drinking water standard. Although this situation does not require that you take immediate action, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct this situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During (compliance period) 2/2016-3/2016 we did not complete all monitoring for (contaminant) STANDARD BACTERIA and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?
